## **Scott Miller Embarks on Third Amtrak Tour: Singer-songwriter says “Use your brain. Use a train.”**

Scott Miller is embarking on his third tour on Amtrak to raise awareness of the erosion of our country's long distance passenger trains. Miller will play six shows along the Amtrak Crescent and Ann Rutledge lines beginning in Washington, DC on November 27 and ending in Chicago on December 6. See dates below.

Miller's trip is a timely one politically. Amtrak services continue to suffer from cutbacks and a crumbling infrastructure. “As sure as the sun will rise the morning after Election Day, so will gas prices. We're not done with \$3/gallon gas. Most predictions say it's gonna go higher than that.... Our nation needs a real and uniform train service. If this is to be done on a national level it's going to require a central command and yes, funding.”

Miller has a special place in his heart for Amtrak. In 2004 he organized the first Mule Train tour, a trip up the eastern seaboard on the Amtrak Crescent (from New Orleans to New York) that earned praise from fans and media alike. Miller was included in a Newsweek Magazine piece on bands using alternative methods of transportation.

Scott Miller is recording a live solo effort in Johnson City, TN for release in early spring, 2007.
